What Makes a Good Moisturizer?

- Products containing ceramide as an ingredient
- Thicker the better.
- <u>Ceramide Moisturizers</u>:
 - ** Eucerin COMPLETE REPAIR 48 hours
 - *CeraVe moisturizing <u>cream</u> (cream thicker/better than lotion)
 - *Cetaphil RESTORADERM Eczema Moisturizing Lotion
 - Goldbond ULTIMATE RESTORATION
 - Curel Exreme Care Intensive Lotion*(ceramide is listed as Cetyl-PG Hydroxyethyl Palitamide)
- <u>Good Non Ceramaide Moisturizers</u>
 - **Avene CICALFATE Hands (but can use anywhere, good thick moisturizer, but expensive)
 - Vanicream the lotions only are free of dyes, lanolin, fragrance, masking fragrance, protein, parabens and formaldehyde, available online at: <u>http://www.allergycanada.com/allergy-canadaproducts/personal-care-products.html</u>
 - Exederm (also no allergens, only available in the US, but can order online at <u>www.exederm.com</u>)

How About a Barrier Cream?

- **Wellskin Barriere Cream: silicon based, easy to use and non-greasy, has mild fragrance and contains parabens
- *Prevex Protectant Cream: petroleum based, no parabens nor fragrance, greasier
- Glysomed hand cream: silicon and petroleum based
- Herbacin hand cream is silicon and glycerin based, fragranced

- Sunlight Sensitive Skin is fragrance free, dye free and hypoallergenic
- Exederm Allergen Free household products and personal care products (found online)
- Cliniderm Shampoo
